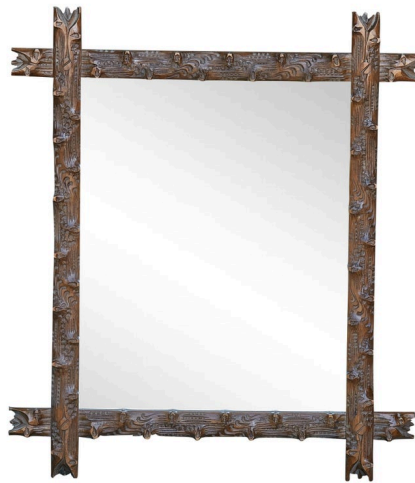


BLACK FOREST 19TH CENTURY WOODEN MIRROR WITH HAND-CARVED WOODEN FRAME
