

ENGLISH 19TH CENTURY OAK BOBBIN LEG TABLE WITH SINGLE DRAWER AND CROSS STRETCHER

An English oak table from the 19th century, with bobbin legs, single drawer. H-Form stretcher and Chippendale style brass hardware. Created in England during the 19th century, this oak table features a rectangular top with slightly raised design and beveled edges, sitting above a single drawer fitted with brass Chippendale style hardware. Its dovetail construction reveals the piece's age. The table is raised on an elegant base made of four bobbin legs with elongated rectangular block joints, connected to one another through an H-Form cross stretcher and side stretchers of similar style. The ensemble is resting on petite feet. With its clean lines and turned accents, this English bobbin leg oak table from the 19th century will make for a wonderful addition to any home, perhaps placed in a living room, bedroom or hallway.
