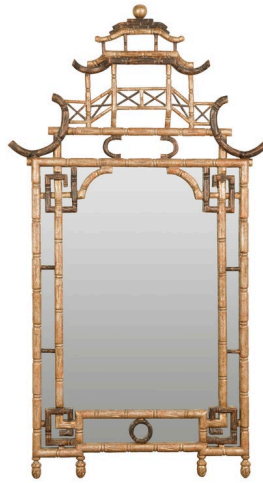


ENGLISH FAUX BAMBOO CARVED PAGODA MIRROR, 20TH CENTURY
