They present a nail construction and are fitted with C-scroll brass handles. The sides are plain and the back, unfinished, reveals the piece's good age. With its clean lines, nice proportions and good age, this English Georgian period oak single door and two drawers buffet from the 18th century will make for a great addition to any home, particularly displayed in a living room.
