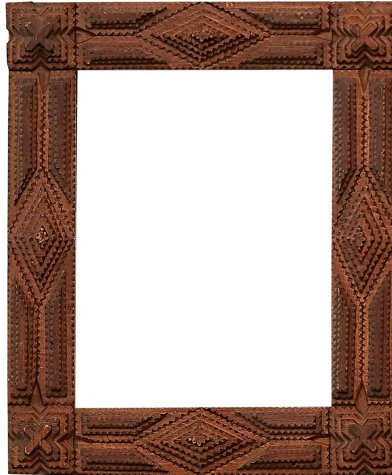


FRENCH 1900S HAND CARVED TRAMP ART MIRROR WITH RAISED DIAMOND MOTIFS

A French rectangular Tramp Art hand carved wooden mirror from the early 20th century, with raised diamond motifs and X patterns. Created in France during the Turn of the Century which saw the transition between the 19th to the 20th, this wall mirror was hand carved in the manner typical of the Tramp Art style. Presenting a rectangular frame, the mirror features a layered texture made of a series of overlapping notches showcasing raised diamonds and other geometric motifs adorning the four sides. The corners are accented with carved X motifs. This frame boasts a brown patina and surrounds a clear mirror providing great reflection. With its nice proportions, skillfully hand-carved décor and brown patina, this hand carved French Tramp Art mirror circa 1900 will make for a great addition to any home, particularly placed in a mountain cabin or country home, perhaps hung above a side table or buffet.
