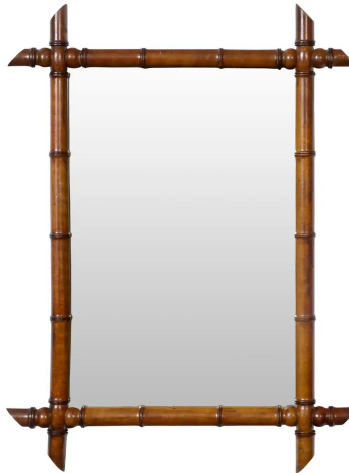


FRENCH TURN OF THE CENTURY BROWN FAUX BAMBOO MIRROR WITH INTERSECTING CORNERS
