A rustic French rectangular faux-bamboo walnut mirror from the early 20th century, with honey brown patina, intersecting corners and slanted accents. Created in France during the Roaring Twenties in the first quarter of the 20th century, this rustic mirror features a rectangular silhouette made of a thin brown faux bamboo walnut frame showcasing intersecting corners with slanted accents at the top, surrounding clear a central mirror plate. The back is made of simple wooden panels. With its simple lines and warm patina, this French walnut faux bamboo mirror circa 1920 charms us with its rustic appearance and lovely color, making it a great choice to decorate any wall, particularly displayed in a mountain cabin or country home, perhaps hung above a side table, a credenza or a commode.
