The table is raised on an interesting base made of four tapered legs with both fluted and reeded accents, angled in the front and straight in the back. The sides echo the façade's décor and the back is unfinished. The table will therefore benefit from being placed against a wall. The ensemble is mounted on arrow feet. Boasting a nicely weathered patina revealing its good age, this Italian Neoclassical bleached oak console table from the 19th century will bring a touch of undeniable elegance to any home, whether placed in a living room, bedroom or foyer.
